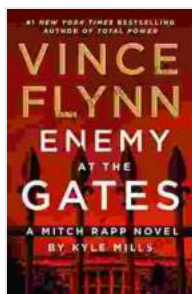


Enemy At The Gates: Mitch Rapp 20

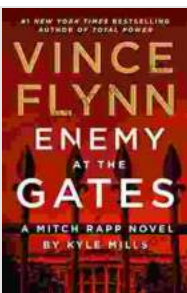

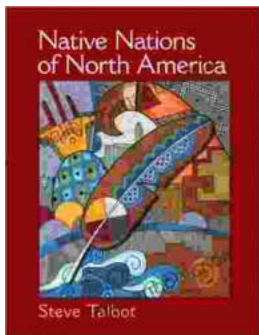
